Annual Report – 2022-23

Introduction:

It is a great honour to produce the Annual Report of the various activities conducted in the Bethel Mission School, Kishanganj during the academic session 2022-23. The school is affiliated with the CBSE Board to Class XII. In this session, the school emphasized on various activities of the school to improve the quality among all the students. Active participation is very important not only in education but also in cultural and social fields. So the school planned a bunch of co-curricular activities.

Academic Calendar:

The academic classes of the session 2022-23 started on 6th April 2022. The selection of class monitors or the school pupil leaders was held on May 2022. The assessment of the school students was taken by three unit tests and two terminal exams in the month of June, September, December and March. According to the academic calendar fixed by the school 257 days were open and all the government gazetted holidays were also followed like every year.

Academic Performance:

In the session year 2021-22 Total 118 students were appeared in the 10th board examination among them 98% students passed. Mohammad Afzal Zamil scored 91.4% and was the class topper, Simmy Naaz stood 2nd with 91%, Priyanshu Chowdhary stood 3rd with 89.4%. On the other hand, 95 students were appeared in the 12th board exam, among them 97% passed. Utkarsh a students from Science scored 92.6% was the school topper, Fariha Anwer from Science with 90.8% and Maherun Muskan from Arts with 90.8% stood second position, Saba Karim from Arts with 89.4% stood 3rd. In the academic year 2022-23, 106 students have been appeared in class X & 64 students in class XII.

Cultural Activity:

Various cultural educational programs require active participation of students to increase their enthusiasm. So we have conducted competitions in folk dance, drama, speech in Hindi, English and Urdu. Drama on innocent victims of Aggression grabbed everyone's attention. Vikram Batra's "Kargil war Drama" was no less. Teacher's Day speech, children's speeches, national devotional songs made the school more cultural.

Fit India Quiz:

Two students, Prince Kumar class VII and Alisha Fatma class VII have entered the preliminary round of the Fit India Quiz 2023. In the Preliminary Test, Prince Kumar secured fourth position and Alisha Fatma secured the eighth position. In this 61980 students from 16702 schools from 702 districts across the country appeared for the preliminary Exam of Fit India Quiz. Fit India Quiz will be organized at the state Level in the Month of April 2023.

In House Teachers Training:



One day In-House Training Program on classroom Management was conducted on 17th August 2022. The Training was conducted by the resource person, Mr. V. Theodore. All the teachers actively participated in the Training which was found to be very useful. It helps us to develop our attitude towards special children and inclusive education. An accessible learning environment is necessary.
