ADMISSION:

The age for admission is six years as on 1st April in the Class-1, Xerox copy of birth certificate has to be deposited at the time of admission. The application for admission along with prospectus can be obtained at the end of December, every year in the school office. The application form for registration duly filled by the parents and submit in the office to collect the admit card for admission test. Admission test will be of two hours duration. Question paper comprises the subjects of English, Hindi, Maths and General Knowledge. Result of the written test will be declared within one week of admission test to get admission. For Class XI admission time is based on the X class Board Exam result.

TO GET ADMISSION IN THE HOSTEL, THE FOLLOWING INSTRUCTIONS ARE FOLLOWED:

Admission will be subject to medical fitness by the medical board of the school. The parents and Guardians are required to be present at the time of admission in the hostel. The candidates are advised not to keep any cash, electrical applianecs (radio, walkman, mobile phones etc) and gold items.

The parents recommended guardians are only allowed to visit the candidates. The parents are also asked to submit duly filled by:

(1) The Medical History (2) Declaration (3) Authorization of local guardian and (4) Three recent coloured passport size photos of the candidate.
